Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 111 of the MFMA (No 56 of 2003) and clause(s) 12(1) & 19(1) of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Policy that Emthanjeni Municipality invites a registered company to submit a clearly detailed proposal for the following service.

Tender /2019: Construction of Britstown Oxidation Ponds for Emthanjeni Municipality

Tender document has a non-refundable deposit of R500.00 payable cash and can be obtained at the Emthanjeni Local Municipality De Aar Office Supply Chain Department upon producing proof of payment. The advert be obtained on the Emthanjeni Local Municipality Website and also on the E-Tender Portal.

The following conditions shall apply:

- The Council is not obliged to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept any tender or portion thereof
- Tenders must be valid for a period of 90 days after the closing date
- Only Bidders registered on the Central Supplier Data Base will be considered
- Emthanjeni Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy will apply and All relevant legislations.
- All documentary proof must be submitted along with the tender
Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT.
A firm delivery period must be indicated.
The tender document must be completed in black Ink by means of a ball point pen. Pencil entries will render the tender offer non-complaint. Computerized/ typed tenders will be disqualified.
The Tender document must be completed on the original tender document. Copies of the tender document or parts thereof will render the document non-responsive.
Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the applicable Preferential Point Scoring System as set out in the Councils Supply Chain Management Policy; Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 snf Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017. The following forms, **MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 6.1, MBD 7.1, MBD 8 and MBD 9** must be completed and submitted with the bid.
- Bids that are late or non-compliant will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
- A minimum CIDB grading of **7CE or higher** is required for this tender.
- No B-BBEE points would be allocated if an original / original certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate is not attached to the bid document. An original certified Sworn

Affidavit may be submitted as an alternative. No points will be allocated if a copy of a sworn certified affidavit is submitted.

- Letter from SARS including PIN to validate TAX clearance and VAT registration should be submitted with the tender offer, the Emthanjeni Local Municipality will confirm the TAX Compliance after tenders are submitted.

Preferences

Preferences are offered to tenderers who comply with the criteria stated in the Tender Data.

Criteria:

Emthanjeni Local Municipality has decided to apply Subcontracting as condition of tender as per Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017: Regulation 9. This will be enforced to the tenderer to subcontract 30% of the value of contract and the municipality will provide list of service providers to be considered for subcontracting.

NB: Any tender that fails to meet regulation 9 of Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017 criteria stipulated in the tender (above) document is an unacceptable tender.

Note: Late tenders, telegraphic tenders or tenders sent by fax or e-mail will not be Considered.

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) and the 80/20 points system will apply.

There will be a compulsory briefing meeting for all interested bidders on 19 March 2019 (Tuesday) at 10h00 at Britstown Municipal Offices, Municipal Building, Britstown and the **TENDER CLOSING DATE IS ON THE 12 APRIL 2019 at 12h00 PM.**
